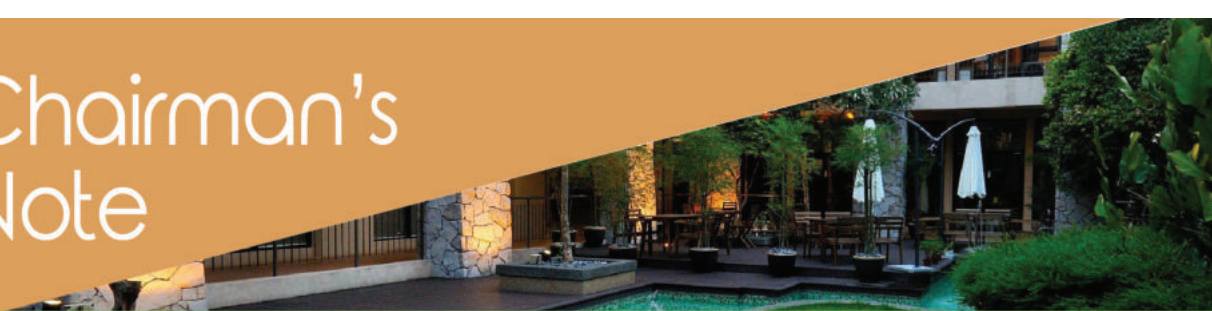
2018: Year In Review

Greetings from Pusat Kreatif Kanak-kanak Tuanku Bainun.

It has been an exciting 2018 for all of us at PKK Tuanku Bainun. As early as January we held Tirai 2018, our annual showcase featuring the heart and soul of PKK Tuanku Bainun, children of our Alam Kreatif programme. The Alam Kreatif programme provides dance, visual arts, theatre, music, and culinary classes for children from all walks of life.

In the 2018 financial year end, the Alam Kreatif programme enrolled over 400 children and youth. Based on the Strengths and Difficulties Questionnaire (SDQ) of which our children were assessed, we are happy to say that children and youth displayed positive behavioural changes after being part of our year-long program.

We have provided free classes to children from shelter homes, orphanages, low income families from government schools (B40), and the

orang asli. This past year, we also extended our repertoire to include juvenile delinquents as well as special needs children.

Alongside including more students, we have also created more ties with the community and garnered meaningful partnerships with local institutions (Resident Association of Taman Tun), government sectors (JKM, JKKN, KEMAS, Ministry of Education), universities (UCSI), local artists (Yusof Gajah, Najib Ahmad Bamadhaj) and designers (BEHATI). We even had the chance to expose children and youth to working with animals at Zoo Negara during Hari Hasanah, a movement created by Yayasan Hasanah, a foundation of Khazanah Nasional.

We strive to empower children and youth, build their confidence, and help them nurture their hidden talents through our creative programmes. One of our initiatives towards our goal is the annual Tuanku Bainun Young Changemaker Awards, an award that was created in conjunction with Universal Children's Day in November. Through this program, we provide a platform for students to share their ideas and thoughts, recognizing that children and youth can make a difference to communities through their initiatives in the realms of society, economy, environment, justice and safety - inspiring not only their peers but adults and communities as well.

Moving forward, we are excited to welcome more children and youth to PKK Tuanku Bainun and will be expanding our programmes to include a diverse range of arts and culture. We will also continue to work hard towards our creative programmes and activities for the benefit of children and youth in our community so they may learn, explore, and expand their creativity.

I would like to take this opportunity to extend my heartfelt gratitude to our grantors, corporate and individual donors, sponsors, partners, educators, parents, carers, volunteers and stakeholders for your unwavering support and generosity. It is with your kindness that we are able to benefit children and youth today.

Opened the Year
with a Bang
13th January 2018



At the beginning of the year, Pusat Kreatif Kanak-kanak Tuanku Bainun celebrated the children of Alam Kreatifs' journey and achievements during Tirai 2018. A total of 129 children ranging from 7-17 years old were part of the showcase.

PKK Tuanku Bainun was buzzing with life as the day started off with a bazaar with a large variety of stalls with goods including delicious meals from food trucks, homemade food and cookies, art, and handmade accessories. Guests enjoyed cooking demonstrations by children from our Alam Kreatif Young Chef classes where they exhibited their culinary skills. The cupcakes and cookies made were then sold at the bazaar with the aim of providing children with hands on entrepreneurship experience.

Throughout the day, attendees also had a go at traditional outdoor games such as Sepak Takraw and gasing. There were also traditional board games, arts and crafts, and busker performances during the event. The main production of Tirai 2018 had a total of 9 performances by children who had undergone a year-long programme by Alam Kreatif. Featured performances included the Tarian Inang from the Dance with Teacher Dida class, the Rhythm and Beats show, a Catwalk Fashion show by Sewing OOTF, Rapsodi & Alam Gamelan performance, an audiobook story presentation and a Mask & Movement performance. The children displayed amazing talent during the showcase, further showing that all children when given an opportunity to perform will shine.

For the second consecutive year, Yayasan Hasanah, a foundation of Khazanah Nasional Berhad has been providing support to Pusat Kreatif Kanak-kanak Tuanku Bainun's Alam Kreatif programmes. They have been instrumental in aiding us to continue our efforts in offering free creative classes to underprivileged children.

The creative classes are aimed at exposing children to living skills, performing arts, and visual arts. Children are encouraged to explore their creativity and discover their talents whilst developing life-long skills that they can carry with them in life.

As part of our mission to keep Malaysian arts, heritage, and culture alive, we incorporated traditional recipes considered close to extinction into our Young Chef programme such as the Kuih Ketayap, Lepat Pisang, and Kuih Lapis.

We also had Angklung, Gamelan and Traditional Dance classes where children were introduced to Malaysian cultural and heritage performing arts. Through this, children were introduced to the world of music and dance, whilst learning social skills such as learning how to focus and work cohesively with others.

Visual arts classes, on the other hand, exposed children to basic skills in drawing where they were encouraged to express their creativity through sketching, drawing, painting, sculpting, and other free form of arts. This provided a platform for children to express their emotions whilst building confidence through their creations.

A Celebration with the Community 2nd June 2018

In the holy month of Ramadhan, Pusat Kreatif Kanak-kanak Tuanku Bainun organized a bazaar featuring an array of items from festive cookies to muslimah wear as well as local handmade bags, crafts and accessories. A total of 15 stalls were set up by independent entrepreneurs and staff.



JKM Graduation Night 2018 3rd July 2018

During this celebration, a total of 40 Alam Kreatif children from Projek Perumahan Rakyat Seri Pantai, Desa Rejang and Perumahan Awam Pahang graduated from the Alam Kreatif programme. This was a collaboration between Pusat Kreatif Kanak-kanak Tuanku Bainun and Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat under the Children Responsive & Active Programme (CREATIVE) and aimed to expose children to arts, heritage & culture as well as introduce beneficial activities to influence children to steer away from social ills and immoral activities.



The children flaunted their talents by performing the Joget Pahang and Tarian Sapu Tangan, playing the Timang Burung and Madu dan Racun on Gamelan, and conducting a live demonstration of making Kuih Ketayap which were served to guests.

Under this programme, the Strengths and Difficulties Questionnaire was used to help gauge behavioral changes in the children during the 3 month programme. Based on observations from their parents and guardians, 60% of the children showed significant positive behavioral changes such as being able to concentrate on tasks, handle stress, get along and be more helpful to others.

Highly Immersive Programme 2018 (HIP) Exhibition

14th - 16th August 2018

This year, Pusat Kreatif Kanak-kanak Tuanku Bainun participated in the Highly Immersive Programme 2018 (HIP) Exhibition organized by the English Language Teaching Centre (ELTC) of the Ministry of Education.

We had many inspiring conversations with teachers from Klang Valley all the way to Terengganu and East Malaysia and we were happy to hear that many schools in Malaysia are working towards a shared belief that children should be exposed to creative learning.

The ELTC's aim was to encourage classes to be taught in English in order to enhance learning. At Pusat Kreatif Kanak-kanak Tuanku Bainun, we are supporting this initiative by injecting the English language in some of our classes such as our Young Chef classes and providing creative classes such as the 7 Skills class in English.

UCSI Shoebox Chicken & Duck CSR Project with Yusof Gajah & PKKTB

2nd September 2018

In September, a collaboration between UCSI University Arts School of Architecture & Built Environment, our Visual Arts Educator, Yusof Gajah, and Pusat Kreatif Kanak-kanak Tuanku Bainun took place. Using architecture as a tool to expose Alam Kreatif children to different means and forms of art, UCSI students created sculptures of chickens and ducks as part of their architecture course. The collaboration provided a platform and opportunity for children to further develop their creativity and open their minds to different types of art forms.

Alam Kreatif children from Rumah Tengku Budriah and UCSI students placed their animal sculptures all around Pusat Kreatif Kanak-kanak Tuanku Bainun to further enhance the learning environment. Art activities and singing sessions were also organized by UCSI students, much to the enjoyment of our Alam Kreatif children.



Embracing Wildlife on Hari Hasanah

14th September 2018

Hari Hasanah (meaning goodness or good deed in Arabic), is a social movement by Yayasan Hasanah, a foundation of Khazanah Nasional Berhad. Hari Hasanah is a chosen day in September every year when Malaysians will be encouraged to perform an extra good deed in support of the movement.

Pusat Kreatif Kanak-kanak Tuanku Bainun staff, together with our Alam Kreatif children from Sekolah Kebangsaan Tunas Bakti, decided that the good deed in 2018 shall be towards animals. It was a remarkable experience for the youth and staff to spend a day volunteering at Zoo Negara Malaysia.

A unique experience where you get your hands dirty and go behind the scenes, tasks included cleaning the animals and their exhibits, preparing food, feeding the animals and learning about the importance of protecting wildlife. It was a rewarding experience as the teenagers were placed in an environment that was out of their comfort zone. The activity brought out their different individual characteristics and their teachers were able to see them respond positively in a new environment and when interacting with animals. The youths adapted well to the tasks given and everyone who volunteered were reminded on the importance of the welfare of all living things.



Music in the Forest 22nd September 2018

The Taman Tugu Project is a CSR initiative by Khazanah Nasional Berhad in collaboration with Kuala Lumpur City Hall (DBKL) with the support of various public sector agencies, private sector companies and civil-society organisations. It is a project dedicated to conserving a 66-acre forest and turning it into an urban forest park for the community.

+Acumen Nonprofit Earned Income Accelerator Course 4th October - 16th November 2018

Under the sponsorship of Yayasan Hasanah, a foundation of Khazanah Nasional Berhad, Pusat Kreatif Kanak-kanak Tuanku Bainun successfully completed the 6-week +Acumen Nonprofit Earned Income Accelerator programme that covered the foundational principles of entrepreneurship and business model development for the nonprofit sector. The project involved developing a prototype to test revenue streams as well as practicing customer discovery, business modelling, financial modelling, and pitching. For the Centre, the aim is to generate a business model to create an income stream and enable us to be self-sustainable. A total of 10 staff were involved in this course.

Field Trip for Preschoolers 18th October

We opened our doors to 150 preschoolers for a fun day out! We facilitated a variety of fun filled activities which carried "Fruit" as the theme of the day. Activities such as the Fruit Dance were conducted where each fruit represented a certain movement and the little ones learned to coordinate to the beat of the song with actions and movements. They also created drawings of fruits where they improved motor skills by drawing and colouring. After, they joined a "Let's Get Cooking" session where they made a fruit salad from scratch and learned the do's & don't's in the kitchen, nutritious information about fruits, and how to prepare a dish of their own.

In 2018, it has been a pleasure to be able to provide creative programmes such as Visual Arts, Traditional Dance and Culinary classes to youths. It has been a wonderful journey to see them grow in their own ways while developing their self-confidence, ability to appreciate working in a team, and moral and spiritual values.

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Sekolah Tunas Bakti is an approved institution for education, training and detention school for children (boys only) established under the Section 65 of the Child Act 2001. It provides rehabilitation to youth who are involved in minor criminal offences.



PUAK Payong Launch & Children Free Market 8th November 2018

Fellow non-profit organization, PUAK Payong: Persatuan Untuk Anak Kita, founded by Syed Azmi Alhabshi, an activist for children in Malaysia, officially launched their organization at PKK Tuanku Bainun on 10th November 2018. In conjunction with their launch, they organized a variety of workshops for children and a kids' bazaar where children set-up stalls selling handmade items and homemade goodies. The Tuanku Bainun Young Changemakers Award 2018 23rd November 2018

In conjunction with Universal Children's Day, the annual Tuanku Bainun Young Changemakers Award 2018 was held on 23rd November 2018. The event was graced by DYMM Raja Permaisuri Perak Darul Ridzuan Tuanku Zara Salim. It is a platform to recognize and celebrate children in Malaysia who are doing amazing things. These extraordinary children's work not only inspires their peers but adults alike.

In its 4th year now in 2018, the award has grown with more submissions from all over the country, and now includes nationwide changemaking workshops, a children's summit and workshops conducted by children for children. 60 remarkable projects and individuals were nominated based on their projects and initiatives aimed at championing peace, safety, justice and equality, eradicating poverty and hunger, preserving and developing sustainable cities and communities, caring for the environment and preventing pollution, and developing community through the economy and humanity.

10 finalists were shortlisted to present their projects during the award ceremony and three were voted to receive the Tuanku Bainun Young Changemakers Award 2018. The audience were impressed by the level of commitment and confidence displayed by these Young Changemakers.

This year, a new Special Mention category was conceived to recognize the Young Changemakers Advocate, a champion adult who has been enabling, supporting, and consistently motivating the children to be better role models to their peers.

Category: Individual 6 - 12 years old

Sarah Najihah binti Mohamad Fauzi - Jitra, Kedah

Sarah Najihah Binti Mohamad Fauzi, 10, from Sekolah Padang Pekan, Jitra, Kedah created and designed her very own handmade soap "Sara Ann Surprise Soap". Her mission is to cultivate and encourage children as early as 6 years old to start taking care of their personal hygiene, especially their hands. She has designed and produced hand-made soaps that contain toys as a form of reward and incentive to encourage children to wash their hands regularly. The idea is that the more they wash their hands, the faster they can get to the toy. She hopes that her contribution to her community will result in greater impact to the future generation.

She has always believed that a generation that cares for cleanliness will produce a healthier and more productive society in the future. Her project is seen as a social investment that will create a healthy society in the future.

Category: Individual 13 - 15 years old

Muhammad Danish bin Agunawan - Kota Kinabalu, Sabah

Muhammad Danish bin Agunawan from Kota Kinabalu, Sabah created a movement to lessen the use of plastics and polystyrene in his community. Current changes that Muhammad Danish has made has resulted in schoolmates not using polystyrene in school and now bring their own food and beverage containers. As he assists in his father's restaurant, he constantly informs customers of his project and customers have begun bringing in food containers and environmentally friendly bag carriers for their take-away. Through his project, he is more confident and aware of the different types of plastics and whether it can be recycled and its effects on health and environment. He has also produced a broom entirely made out of recycled plastic bottles and convinced his friends to produce more brooms to be used in their school. With that, they are able to reduce the school's cost of purchasing new brooms and make use of the plastic bottles that are not being recycled.

Category: Group Projects

Hands For Education by Sri KDU Secondary School - Kota Damansara, Selangor

Hands for Education is an independent student initiative comprising children from ages 13-17 years old. Their aim is to help underprivileged students excel academically and grow holistically through weekly peer-to-peer mentoring sessions by preparing students with the skills needed to face exams and life. At the end of the day they hope to be able to uplift their socio-economic status and break out of the poverty cycle through meaningful and effective education where they are not left behind. They have an apathetic attitude towards their financial state, their homes and their own community. There seems to be a lack of motivation to improve themselves and the state of their surroundings. They found that most of the residents living there have very similar mindsets which may contribute to their lifestyle and their inability to break out of the poverty cycle. Hands for Education believes this programme will not only make it easier for them to integrate into society when they get older but it can also create a generation thriving with successful leaders, performers, entrepreneurs and so on.

Special Mention - Young Changemakers Advocate

Ernest Kelly Subin - Tamparuli, Sabah

Since 2015, this teacher has successfully created a team to run community-assisted project. Among the projects: Building a flood safety tool to save lives of street users (2015), Easy Pipe Filter (2017) to help solve Tamparuli villagers water supply woes. Many students are inspired to join his team. One of his student groups - BBKK2.0 - was the winner of the group category for Young Changemakers Award Tuanku Bainun 2017.

Moving on the Right Track! December 2018

In addition to the yearly accounting audit by PricewaterhouseCoopers, PKK Tuanku Bainun also conducts an annual audit on our Alam Kreatif programme framework to ensure that we stay true to the Framework created by the Steering Community when we started operations in June 2013. This framework guides us in providing a haven of creativity and artistic expression for children and youth regardless of income, gender, religion, language or ability.

The purpose of the audit is to acquire an independent opinion on the Alam Kreatif programme to ensure proper implementation of the Framework. The audit findings are not only used by PKK Tuanku Bainun to improve but to also demonstrate transparency and accountability to stakeholders.

This year's audit was conducted by Ms. Janet Pillai, a researcher, practitioner and activist in the field of arts and culture education. She specializes in creative pedagogy, cultural research, community-outreach and is a leading figure in South East Asian arts education.



Programmes

What is Alam Kreatif?



Alam Kreatif by Pusat Kreatif Kanak-kanak Tuanku Bainun is an arts education programme that is designed to mobilize creative thinking and innovation in young people through the use of arts, play, and imagination as a creative tool as well as a medium of expression. Programmes and workshops include performing, visual, and literary arts as well as living skills to create a balanced, meaningful and holistic arts education for young people that complements the formal school curriculum.

We encourage children aged 7-17 years old from all walks of life regardless of income, gender, religion, language or ability to participate in our creative programmes. Special efforts are made to accommodate children with special needs, underprivileged children and children deprived of proper access to basic education. Most importantly, children will have an appropriate platform to express their talents and interests as well as find new ones that we hope will last a lifetime.

Alam Kreatif conducts both paid and sponsored creative classes and workshops.

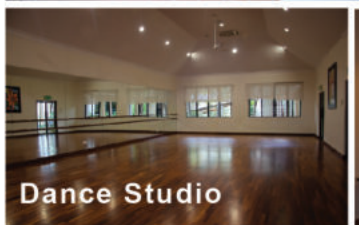

In general, a specified number of tables and chairs, PA System, complimentary wi-fi. It varies depending on the venue.

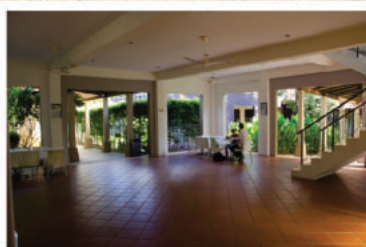
