It has been an exciting year for us. Two important events took place in 2017: the signing ceremony between Special Olympics Kuala Lumpur and Pusat Kreatif Kanak-kanak Tuanku Bainun in May and with Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat WP Kuala Lumpur (JKM WPKL) in September that will enable 80 children from Projek Perumahan Rakyat and Perumahan Awam to participate in our Alam Kreatif programmes.

In January, we had our first theatre production, Tales of a City By the Sea, a story of two people who meet and fall in love in the besieged Gaza Strip. This play depicts the faith, humour, struggle and resilience of those living in, or affected by the Gaza siege of 2008.

In April, the Gema Gemalai showcase entranced some very important and distinguished guests with their performances.

In July, Pusat Kreatif Kanak-kanak Tuanku Bainun's Alam Gamelan Performers were invited to perform at Khazanah Raya Open House at the Majestic Hotel. This was the first time that our Alam Gamelan performers have performed outside PKK Tuanku Bainun.

We held our first Charity Art Auction in September at Theatre KuAsh to raise funds for Pusat Kreatif Kanak-kanak Tuanku Bainun. Beautiful paintings by well-known local artists were put up for viewing for 4 days before being auctioned off on Sunday, 24th September.

We had our Tuanku Bainun Young Changemakers Awards 2017 in November. Her Royal Highness Raja Permaisuri Perak Darul Ridzuan Tuanku Zara Salim graced this event.

We will close our curtains with our Open Day and Showcase - TIRAI 2018 on 13th January 2018. It has been a wonderful year for us. We are looking forward to the Open Day and TIRAI 2018 where our children will get to showcase their talents and creativity.


PKK Tuanku Bainun's Fundraising dinner and fashion show in collaboration with the International Islamic Fashion (IFF) at the end of the year.

PKK Tuanku Bainun brought this award-winning Australian theatre production onto Malaysian shores. The Tales of a City by the Sea (Malaysian Edition) was produced by PKK Tuanku Bainun's Board of Director, YTM Dato' Seri Noraini Jane Marree Ariffin and this is the first theatre production by us. Local artistes included YM Raja Emina Ashman and Tria Aziz.



Open Day

22nd January

The Open Day was a day filled with fun activities and bazaars that was opened to the public so they can explore what we have to offer.

Activities included the Drum Circle, Gamelan by Rapsodi (our in-house Gamelan Players), Arts & Crafts, Creative Storytelling Cooking, Baking and Sewing.







The enchanting Gema Gemalai Showcase, a maiden public performance by talented students, was the culmination of the Joget Gamelan Sustainability and Cultural Heritage Project by PKK Tuanku Bainun and PUSAKA, supported by Yayasan Hasanah, a foundation of Khazanah Nasional Bhd. This showcase was funded with the proceeds from Malam Terang Bulan 2015.

This project aims to enhance the conservation of Joget Gamelan, a royal court tradition of Terengganu, by training 52 students from Terengganu and Kuala Lumpur in the art.

This delightful showcase was graced by Her Royal Highness Raja Permaisuri Perak Darul Ridzuan, Tuanku Zara Salim and PKK Tuanku Bainun's Chairman, YTM Raja Dato' Seri Azureen binti Sultan Azlan Shah.

24th September

Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat Wilayah Persekutuan Kuala Lumpur (JKM WPKL) and PKK Tuanku Bainun entered into a collaboration on children's creative programme with the signing of an MoU at TemuTamu Hall in September.

The MoU was signed by Puan Wan Noraidah, JKMWPKL Director, and YM Pn Raja Mazlena, PKK Tuanku Bainun's General Manager, and witnessed by PKK Tunku Bainun's Chairman, Raja Dato' Seri Azureen binti Sultan Azlan Shah.

This collaborative children's creativity programme aims to expose children and teenagers from Projek Perumahan Rakyat (PPR) and Perumahan Awam (PA) to the arts, heritage and culture through our Alam Kreatif Programmes for underprivileged children and to fill their spare time with beneficial activities rather than social ills and immoral activities. With this in mind, JKM WPKL and PKK Tuanku Bainun have taken this initiative to open and steer the minds of these children towards a goal.

For Deepavali, children from Zotung Refugees Catholic Learning Centre (ZRCLC), under the supervision of our educator Miss Mandy, created a Kolam at our centre. It was an afternoon of creativity and fun and a beautiful Kolam was produced by the children.





The Young Changemakers is a platform for children in Malaysia who are doing amazing things or are amazing persons themselves; to be recognised and celebrated for their courage, resilience and inspiring contributions so they may inspire others, especially their peers.

In conjunction with Universal Children's Day, four children took to the stage to receive the Tuanku Bainun Young Changemakers Awards 2017 on 22nd November 2017 at the Theatre KuAsh.

Her Royal Highness Raja Permaisuri Perak Darul Ridzuan Tuanku Zara Salim graced the ceremony with her presence and witnessed the finalists as they presented the causes they were championing in the areas of technology and innovation, the environment, community development, and the arts. Out of 60 Young Changemakers nominees from all across Malaysia, ten were shortlisted as finalists and three emerged with the title of Young Changemakers 2017.







Winners of The Tuanku Bainun Young Changemakers Awards 2017

1. Individual 6-12 years category

Andrew Kuik Jie En from Seri Kembangan Selangor.

Andrew, a 12 year old piano prodigy raised RM65,300 at his first solo recital in September 2017 for the National Autism Society of Malaysia, and to buy a piano for his alma matter, SJKC Shin Cheng (Ladang Harcroft). Andrew wants to use his own passion in the arts to raise awareness and money for causes he believes in.



2. Individual 13-15 year old category

13 year old app developer Ellysha created an educational app called zoogle that won the 2016 Technology Innovation for Globalisation by MDec. She will represent Malaysia at the Global Entrepreneurship Summit in India. She believes that everyone can shape the future by empowering one another to succeed.

3. Group Category

This group of 16 year old Sabahan students entered the MyHarapan Social project Challenge to address clogged water sources faced by villagers in their area. Led by Arico John, Jesslyssa, Shelcy, Jenevy, Preshly and Vincent Kualah, BBKK developed the easy pipe Filter (E.P.F.) that filters debris from natural streams to provide about 2000 villagers with clean water. The team aspires to solve more problems to benefit villagers around Sabah.



Finally, one group was given a **Special Mention Award** for their enthusiastic presentation. This went to SJKT Kajang Interact Club.
